Duties will be on going as new skills are acquired but will likely involve the following:

- Control panel enclosure door marking, drilling, hole punching & population.
- Control panel backplate layout design, drilling and populating.
- Install electrical wiring and assemble components in control cabinets, electrical and industrial equipment, and related industrial apparatus, according to blueprint wiring diagrams.
- Lay out diagrams for electrical installations according to wiring specifications.
- Attaches breakers, relays, contactors, Terminals, bus bars, transformers.
- Cuts, strips, bends, and forms wire cable, conduit, pipe, and tubing used to connect circuits subassemblies, using hacksaw, bandsaw, pipe cutters, and mechanical or hydraulic pipe or cable benders
- Solders connections and crimps connectors to wire ends, using soldering iron pliers
- Tests and adjusts electrical assemblies, using electricians hand tools test equipment.

Apprentices Responsibilities:
